April 19, 2022

The regular meeting of the Davidson Town Council was held in the Davidson Town Auditorium on April 19, 2022.

**Agenda**

2022-57 Siroski-Belisle: That the agenda be approved as amended.  
LePoudre: Carried.

**Emergency Response Services – Bylaw No. 803**
