RV Trailer Storage – We are again offering trailer storage at the campground. Please contact the Town Office for details and to make arrangements for your trailer storage.

Back Alleys – Back alleys are not the place to pile your grass clippings, tree trimmings, rocks, broken down vehicles or garbage that should be hauled to the landfill. We have had numerous complaints in this regard. Let's take some pride on our properties and clean them up. Grass clippings and garden waste can be hauled to the compost bins, trees, rocks and garbage should be hauled to the landfill on a timely basis. All vehicles need to be parked on your property. Having all of this material in the back alleys attracts rodents, and makes it difficult for the town to maintain in the summer and nearly impossible to get down to clear snow in the winter.

Tree Disposal - There is no longer a place to dump your trees and branches in town. The Vet Clinic where we had a tree disposal area has been shut down due to misuse of the service. Branches and yard waste are always accepted at the landfill free of charge. The landfill is open Wednesdays and Saturdays 9 am – 5 pm.

Compost Bins – A reminder as you do your fall yard/garden clean up that there are compost bins available behind the town shop. Please remove any bags.

Hedge Trimming – Take advantage of the gorgeous fall weather and trim back any trees and hedges that are hanging over or growing out onto the sidewalk and making it difficult for people to use the sidewalks.

Garbage Bins - If you put a fence up on your side and back property lines, please make sure you allow for space to put your garbage can or holder inside your fence/property line. Garbage bins on the outside of your property line encroach on the town's alleys causing issues when we grade or do snow removal.

Property Taxes – are due by December 31, 2022. We accept the following methods of payment: cash, cheque, credit card, debit, online banking, and post-dated cheques. Consider sending in your payment early to avoid any mail delays!

Put one dye strip in the toilet tank at the back, don't flush, if the bowl has blue water in the next 30 minutes, your toilet is leaking and needs repairing.
