Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors - As of July 1, 2022 - the new CCA and building regulations require all existing residential buildings to have smoke and Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms.

- Smoke alarms must be installed on each storey (including basement) in each sleeping room and hallways within 5 m of sleeping rooms.
- Smoke alarms must be hard wired and interconnected.
- **The exception:** building constructed prior to June 6, 1988. Battery operated is allowed, but must be sealed with a 10-year battery.
- CO alarms must be installed on each storey.
- CO alarms must be hard wired and interconnected.
- **The exception:** buildings constructed prior to October 1, 2009. Battery operated is allowed, but must be a sealed unit with a 10-year battery.

Building Permits – We are always excited to see new work happening in town!! Remember to apply for your building permit, in advance, to give the building inspectors ample time to go through the information, before approving you to proceed. It can take 2 or more weeks during the busy summer season. This includes garages, decks, renovations, basement development, etc. It is always best to check, with the office, before you begin the project so you are compliant and don't get delayed with shut downs.

Bylaws – We have two new that were passed at the March Council Meeting. Commercial and Residential Tax Incentive Bylaw and the Updated Cemetery Bylaw. Please take time to check out both bylaws on our website. There is also a handout at the Town Office with a condensed version of the rules and regulations.

Glass Recycling Program – Council renewed the agreement with SARCAN for glass recycling. Under this program glass containers can be taken to SARCAN, instead of discarding them into the garbage/landfill. We estimate the cost of this program to be approximately \$1,000.00 for the year.

Garbage – Thank you to everyone who attended the March 7th Waste Management Open House. Council and Loraas Representatives answered questions and received positive feedback around waste disposal. At the March 21st Council Meeting the decision was made to contract Loraas Disposal to collect garbage and haul it to their landfill. Plans are to have Loraas garbage collection in place by the end of May.

New Recreation Director - The **Town of Davidson would like to welcome Dave Whitenect** as our new Recreation Director. He joined our team January 16th and has hit the ground running. He looks forward to meeting the residents of Davidson and hearing what recreation and culture programs they would like to see offered not only at the rinks and the pool but in the community as a whole.
