



# Please Be Mindful / Did You Know?

**Tax Payments by Credit Card** - If you are going to be making a payment with your debit or credit card you may have a daily limit on it. If you do have a limit, you can call your banking institution or credit card company and request a temporary increase in your daily limit and then you will be able to use your card to make the payment without any hassle.

**Property Taxes** – are due by December 31, 2023. We accept the following methods of payment: cash, cheque, credit card, debit, online banking, and post-dated cheques. Consider sending in your payment early to avoid any mail delays! You can also set up with your bank to do monthly payments towards your taxes.

**Water Meters** - The Town is needing to create an inventory of the type and size of water meter that is in place in every home. If you haven't yet, please help us out by taking a picture of the face of your water meter from inside your home, and emailing it to the Town Office ([office@townofdavidson.com](mailto:office@townofdavidson.com)). We have plans to replace 100 water meters this fall.

**Garbage & Recycle Carts** - Please remove your garbage and recycle carts from the street as soon as possible after pickup. We have multiple people leaving their carts on the street for days after and it is causing issues with traffic and will soon hinder snow removal.

**Tree Pruning** - We'd like to remind residents that all trees, shrubs, and hedges are to be regularly pruned so they do not overhang or encroach on any sidewalk. Any branches extending over sidewalks should be trimmed to a minimum height of 8 feet.

**Back Alleys** – Back alleys are not the place to pile your grass clippings, tree trimmings, rocks, broken down vehicles or garbage that should be hauled to the landfill. We have had numerous complaints in this regard. Let's take some pride in our properties and clean them up. Grass clippings and garden waste can be hauled to the compost bins, trees, rocks and garbage should be hauled to the landfill on a timely basis. All vehicles need to be parked on your property. Having all of this material in the back alleys attracts rodents, and makes it difficult for the town to maintain in the summer and nearly impossible to get down to clear snow in the winter.

If you think your water bill is unusually high, come to the Town Office and pick up one of these Leaky Toilet Test Kits.

Put one dye strip in the toilet tank at the back, don't flush, if the bowl has blue water in the next 30 minutes, your toilet is leaking and needs repairing.

Keep in mind that this was a very hot dry summer and watering grass, etc. uses a lot of water.
