**Tax Payments by Credit Card** - If you are going to be making a payment with your debit or credit card you may have a daily limit on it. If you do have a limit, you can call your financial institution or credit card company and request a temporary increase in your daily limit and then you will be able to use your card to make the payment without any hassle. To help with budgeting, we do accept postdated or partial payments throughout the year.
