Dog License – Have you registered your puppy with a 2024 Dog License yet? Please be a good neighbor and keep your dog on your property and with either a secure restraint or fence. Help your puppy be a law-abiding pup!

Business Licenses are also due. Pick up your Business License and get your business profile added to our Town of Davidson website.

Fire Fees – If there is a fire in the Town of Davidson, the Town of Davidson pays the fire invoice. If it is a false call and you don't call 911 to cancel the call before the Fire Department leaves the hall with the trucks, the owner of the property will be invoiced \$512.50 for the False Fire Call.

Building Permits – We are always excited to see new work happening in town!! Remember to apply for your building permit in advance, to give the building inspectors ample time to go through the information and give their approval for you to proceed. It can take two or more weeks during the busy summer season. This includes garages, decks, renovations, basement development, etc. It is always best to check with the office before you begin the project so you are compliant, and don't get delayed with shut downs.

Avoid Extra Fees - Helpful Hints

Extra fees might be charged if there are issues with a project, if it extends past the permit expiration date, or if orders have to be issued. How to avoid extra fees:

- Apply for a permit before starting a building project. It can be costly to make changes to already constructed components if elements are not in compliance with the Building Code.
- Call for the inspections required in the plan review.
- Contact your Licensed Building Official prior to making any changes to your project.
- Complete your project before the expiry date.



Demolition Permits

Demolitions and moving a building cannot start until a valid permit has been issued by the municipal office.

Owners must:

- Meet all municipal requirements for demolition or removal.
- Have all underground facilities located prior to commencing demolition and removal.
- Obtain prior written approval from the Local Authority if it is necessary to close or block any road, street, lane, or sidewalk.
- Supply and maintain, at their own expense, all fencing and boarding or barricades required to warn and protect the public from the work in progress (as per 2020 NBC 8.2.1.3.).
- Dispose of and handle hazardous material in compliance with provincial regulations. For guidance, visit [Publications Saskatchewan](#).
