# Please Be Mindful / Did You Know?

**Dog License** – We have new dog tag! According to our Town Bylaw No. 751 Schedule A, all dogs must be licensed annually. Come on in and get your dog licensed & have a law-abiding pup. By registering your puppy, if it accidentally gets away from you, we can identify it and contact you to help us get your beloved pet home safely to you!

**Snow Angels** – In the midst of winter, we want to send a thank you to all the snow angels that go above and beyond to help their neighbors (with snow shoveling, snow blowing, etc.). It is a great community that looks out for each other.

**Backyard Snow**— Our staff were not able to get into a lot of backyards to do this quarterly water meter reading (snow, locked gates, etc.) Please think of this when you are moving snow. We would appreciate it if you would keep the walkway to the readers cleared out, this will decrease the time spent trying to track residents down to email in their readings. We will be reading meters again in mid-March.

Meter Changes – Thank you for all of you that allowed us to come in and change out your water meters. We are no longer able to read the following meters (ABB, Elster, Kent, Trident, etc.) outside due to our old reading machine quitting and those brands being obsolete. We were able to change about 250 meters in 2024. If you

have one of the above meters we will start changing meters again soon.

Sidewalks & Fire Hydrants — For those of you that keep your sidewalks cleaned off for people to get around easier, it is greatly appreciated. Please be mindful of where you put your snow when shoveling or blowing it. Don't push it out onto the street, on your neighbour's property, street corners which cause visibility issues for pedestrians and traffic, and don't block fire hydrants.

#### \*\*Reminder\*\*

For Public Works to remove snow from the streets following a snow fall, residents and businesses are asked to remove <u>ALL</u> vehicles from the streets as soon as possible. Infrequently used vehicles should not be parked on the street, unless you can move them on time for snow removal.



Please do not leave your Recycle & Garbage Carts on the street.



### **Priority Snow Clearing for the Town of Davidson**

The following is the outline of how the Town of Davidson will approach clearing the streets after a snowstorm. The priorities are set out with #1 being the highest priority and going down from there:

- 1. <u>Top priority</u> will be the streets that go to the hospital and the access to that facility. The streets involved would be Government Road, Railway, Garfield, and Enterprise Lane (access to water plant, and likely busiest road we have).
- 2. <u>Second priority</u> is the business areas, Coxworth, AGT Centre, and The Manor on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.
- 3. The third priority would be residential streets. Priority would be set by staff according to the direction of the wind and the largest snow cover on the streets.
- 4. Back alleys.
