8. Assisting the Pool Manager and Recreation Director with staff scheduling and supervision

Pool Manager

Job Requirements:

- First aid/CPR-C/AED
- National Lifeguard Award
- Lifesaving Instructor Award
- WHIMIS certification
- Pool Operator Level 1 or ability to obtain

Job Responsibilities:

1. Safeguards the public and responds to emergency situations according to standards.
2. Conducts daily safety checks and performs daily water tests
3. Ensures pool is prepared for scheduled events
4. Cleaning and general maintenance duties
5. Effective communication with the public
6. Performs general clerical duties such as accepting payments for swim lessons and public swimming
7. Assists in preparing for facility for operation (May) and assists in closing the facility at end of season (August)
8. Performs administration duties as required
9. Assists the Recreation Director with staff scheduling and staff supervision
10. Assists the Recreation Director with program planning and program evaluation

Summer Labourer Positions

Duties and responsibilities include assist in any general labour works tasks, which may include painting, tree trimming, waste pickup, mowing and operation of equipment, campground and ball diamond maintenance, and other tasks as assigned.

These seasonal positions require up to 35-40 hours a week, starting middle of May until the end of August.

The ideal candidates are self motivated individuals that recognize areas for improvement and are comfortable doing physical labour, must have a current Class 5 driver's license. Multiple positions are available.

Canada Summer Jobs Grant
