#### Planning a Project? Don't Forget Your Building

<u>Permit!</u> – We love seeing new projects and improvements happening around town! Just a reminder to apply for your building permit *before* starting any work. This allows our building inspectors enough time to review your application and approve your project. During the busy summer season, the approval process can take two weeks or more—so planning ahead is key.

Permits are required for many types of work, including garages, decks, renovations, basement developments, and more. When in doubt, give the Town Office a quick call before you begin. It's the

best way to stay compliant and avoid unnecessary delays or shutdowns.

<u>Dog License</u> – As outlined in Town Bylaw No. 751 (Schedule A), all dogs must be licensed annually. Stop by the Town Office to register your dog and make sure your furry friend is a law-abiding pup! Licensing not only keeps you in compliance—it also helps us return your pet safely if they ever get loose. With a tag and up-to-date info, we can quickly identify your dog and contact you. Let's keep our pets safe and our community responsible!

<u>Meter Changes</u> – Thank you to all of you that allowed us to come in and change out your water meters. We are no longer able to read the following meters (ABB, Elster, Kent, Trident, etc.) outside due to our old reading machine quitting and those brands being obsolete. We were able to change about 250 meters in 2024. If you have one of the above meters, we will start changing meters again soon as time allows this spring.

<u>Business Licenses</u> – If you run a business from your home, you're required to complete a business license application. Forms are available on our website, at the Town Office, or we'd be happy to email one to you. Also, if your business isn't currently listed on our website and you'd like it to be, reach out to the office for details on how to get it added. We're here to help you stay compliant and get the word out about your business!

<u>Let's Keep Our Neighbourhood Safe and Beautiful</u> – Everyone deserves to live in a clean, safe, and attractive community. Residents and property owners are reminded that it's their responsibility to maintain their properties and keep them free from:

- Garbage and debris
- Abandoned or dismantled vehicles and machinery
- Overgrown grass and weeds
- Open holes or excavations that could pose safety risks or attract pests By doing your part, you help make our neighbourhood a better place for

everyone. Thank you for your cooperation!

<u>Friendly Reminder to Pet Owners</u> – For the comfort and safety of everyone in our community, please ensure your dogs are properly contained—either within a fenced area or on a leash while walking. Letting pets roam freely is against local bylaws.

### Did you know the Town offers commercial and residential tax incentives?

To support growth and encourage new development, Council passed a bylaw in 2023 offering tax incentives for both residential and commercial projects in Town. These incentives range from 25% to 100% tax abatement and apply to:

- New residential construction
- New or expanded commercial development
