Tax Payments by Credit Card - If you plan to pay with your debit or credit card, please note that your card may have a daily limit. You can contact your financial institution or credit card company to request a temporary increase to ensure your payment goes through smoothly. To help with budgeting, we also accept postdated or partial payments throughout the year.

Oil Recycle Centre – The Oil Recycle Centre is open until Friday October 11th. The Oil Recycle Centre hours are as follows: Wednesdays & Thursdays 8 am – noon and 1 pm – 5 pm & Fridays 8 am – noon.

IS YOUR TOILET LEAKING?

Toilets use the most water out of all our household appliances. They are also the most common source of household leaks. One leaky toilet can waste 3,000 L of water a month. Take the leaky toilet test to find out if you have a leak!

1 

Remove the toilet tank cover and add a few drops of food colouring into the tank

2 

Wait 10-15 minutes (do not flush)

3 

If the water in the toilet bowl changes colour, you've got a leak

4 

Repair your toilet to save water (and money)
